Intended use

The device is intended exclusively for heating and melting paraffin wax with a low melting point.

The device is intended for professional use only.

The device may only be operated indoors.

Any other use is non-intended use.

The manufacturer and supplier accept no liability for damage caused by improper use.

Notes on treatment

The treatment of persons with melted paraffin is the responsibility of the person treating them.

Please note that this treatment is not suitable for persons with venous insufficiency (varicose veins), weak capillaries, spider veins or skin irritations.

The temperature of the liquid wax is adjustable. Maximum temperature: 58°C (136.4°F).

Make sure that the wax is not too hot.
Only use the wax of a paraffin filling for one person.



Basic safety instructions

Hazards due to electricity



WARNING

Only connect the device to a suitable mains supply. Observe the information on the type plate. Incorrect operating voltage can lead to hazards due to electrically overloaded components.

Do not connect the device to the power supply until the following conditions are met:

- > The mains supply to which the device is connected must comply with the applicable regulations for electrical installations in residential buildings.
- > The mains supply is designed for the maximum power of the device.
- > The socket and plug of the device match.

If in doubt, consult a qualified electrician.

For better protection, we recommend installing a residual-current circuit breaker in the circuit supplying power to the device. Maximum nominal operating residual current: 30 mA. Consult a qualified electrician for this.

Observe the basic rules for handling electrical equipment:

- > If possible, do not use adapters, multiple sockets or extension cords. If the use of these elements is necessary after all, only use adapters that comply with the applicable safety standards and that are designed for the maximum power of the device.
- > Do not pull on the mains cable or on the device to pull the plug out of the socket.
- > Disconnect the device from the mains supply before cleaning and maintenance work.



Hazards due to damaged device



WARNING

Only use the device if it is undamaged. Unplug the mains plug if you notice any unusual heat development, smell or smoke.

Do not use the device if it has been subjected to a strong impact, for example if the device has fallen on the floor. Even if no external damage is visible, electrical components may be damaged. There is then a risk of electric shock when touching. In this case, have the device checked by the manufacturer or an authorised service centre before using it again.

Hazards due to unauthorised operation



WARNING

Do not leave the device unattended when it is switched on.

Ensure that only authorised persons work with the device. Ensure that the device cannot be used by children or persons with disabilities.

Also keep the packaging material away from these people. Parts of the packaging material may be a suffocation hazard.

Hazards due to wetness and humidity



WARNING

Always keep the device dry. Do not expose the device to the elements.

Do not touch the device with wet or damp hands or when you are barefoot.

Do not operate the device near bathtubs, sinks or other containers with water.

Do not hold the device under running water or immerse it in water or any other liquid.

Do not touch the device if it has fallen into a liquid.

Danger of electric shock!

Always disconnect the device from the mains after use, as proximity to water can be dangerous even when the device is switched off.



Hazards due to incorrect use



DANGER

Do not operate the device in rooms containing flammable or explosive substances or vapours. These include alcohol, petrol, insecticides and sprays.

Keep combustible materials such as paper, cardboard, textiles and cloths away from the device.

Danger of fire or explosion!

Always disconnect the device from the mains supply when you are not working with the device.

Do not wrap the mains cable around the paraffin container. This could damage the cable and cause a hazard.



WARNING

Remove the paraffin wax packaging before filling the wax.

Only fill wax in a solid state.

Never fill more than 3 kg of wax.

The device must not be empty when switched on. Only switch on the device when there is wax in the device.

Do not fill the device with water. Do not put any liquids or substances other than paraffin into the device.

Keep the room where the paraffin wax is stored clean.



WARNING


Wax that is too hot on the skin can cause pain. Unpredictable, jerky movements of the person being treated can lead to further hazards.

Only dip hands, elbows or feet into liquid wax when the temperature control knob is set to a value lower than 5 and the red indicator light is NOT lit.

Before carrying out any cleaning work: Switch off the device, disconnect the mains cable and wait until the unit has cooled down completely.



Product description



- 1 Lid
- 2 Paraffin container

Operation

- 1. Place the device on a stable and level surface.
- 2. Make sure that the paraffin container is dry. There must be no more cleaning liquid on the walls of the container.
- 3. Connect the device to a socket using the mains cable.
- Fill 3 kg of paraffin wax into the paraffin container in such a way that the wax has surface contact with the bottom of the container.
- 5. Close the lid.
- 6. Turn on the mains switch.
- 7. Turn the temperature control knob to 10 (maximum temperature).

The device starts to heat.

The LOW indicator light is on as long as the desired temperature has not yet been reached.

When the desired temperature is reached, the OK indicator light lights up.

- 8. After 150 minutes, turn the temperature control knob to a value between 3 and 5.
- 9. Make sure that the red HIGH indicator light has gone out. Wait until this is the case, if necessary.

The melted wax is at the correct application temperature when the temperature control knob is set to a value lower than 5 and the OK indicator light is on.











Cleaning

Cleaning the empty device



WARNING

Before carrying out any cleaning work: Switch off the device, disconnect the mains cable and wait until the unit has cooled down completely.



Do not hold the device under running water or immerse it in water or any other liquid.

Use a soft cloth soaked in cleaning fluid to remove wax residues on the housing. Use RUCK® beautykultur Equipment Cleanser, item no. 4080701, to gently clean the device.

Do not use corrosive or abrasive cleaning agents or solvents to clean the device. Use only the recommended cleaning fluid. Other cleaning agents may damage the device or produce toxic fumes when heated.

After cleaning, wait until the cleaning liquid has completely evaporated before switching the device on again.

Removal of old wax

If the paraffin is solid, switch on the device for a few minutes until the edges of the paraffin have melted and come away from the wall of the container.

Switch the device off and unplug the mains plug.

Press the paraffin block down slightly at one end, causing it to tilt. Now you can take the paraffin out of the container. Do not use sharp or pointed objects to remove hard paraffin.



Disposal
